- 5. Three letters of recommendation from individuals who can address your potential for success in the music field.**
- 6. The applicant may include a request indicating financial need. While “need” will be considered, it is not, of itself, qualifying criteria, and documentation of need may be requested.**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be an entering freshman in a four year college or university in the fall following high school graduation.
2. **Must major in a Music or Theater Arts degree program** leading to certification in vocal performance, musical theatre (drama), or teaching certification in choral music or theater arts.
3. Must be enrolled in the high school choir class and/or theater arts class for the fall and spring terms of the junior and senior years.

REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL:

1. The scholarship (up to \$8000) is awarded for eight consecutive semesters. If there is a break in attendance, the scholarship is forfeited.
2. Student must continue to pursue a major in an eligible music degree program.
3. Student must remain in good standing as a student, maintain a 2.5 grade point average (on a 4 point scale), and be enrolled for a minimum of twelve hours each semester.
4. Student must furnish, each semester, a transcript of college courses completed.
