Your completed application packet must include the following:

- 1. This application cover sheet, printed legibly and signed by your counselor**
- 2. A copy of your official high school transcript**
- 3. A typed résumé outlining your extracurricular activities, work and/or community service, and accomplishments**
- 4. A short essay (1-2 pages, typed) describing your reasons for pursuing a career in your chosen field of study.**
- 5. Two letters of recommendation from individuals who can address your potential for success in the chosen field of study**
- 6. The applicant may include a request indicating financial need. While “need” will be considered, it is not, of itself, qualifying criteria, and documentation of need may be requested.**

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ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be an entering freshman in a four-year college or university in the fall following high school graduation.
2. All college majors are eligible for consideration; however, priority will normally be given to those intending to pursue a course of study leading to a career in science or technology.

REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL:

1. A scholarship of \$10,000 per year, renewable for up to four years, will be awarded to Rockport-Fulton High School graduating senior planning to attend an accredited 4-year college or university.
2. For the scholarship to renew, the student must remain in good standing [i.e. not be on probation for academic or other reasons], maintain a 2.5 average (on a 4 point scale), and be enrolled for a minimum of twelve hours each semester.
3. A copy of a transcript of college courses completed must be submitted to The Education Foundation each semester.
